Public libraries have been an essential part of our country for centuries, and it's difficult to imagine our communities without them. They are not only a part of our lives, but they change lives by opening doors to new ideas and opportunities that some people may not otherwise be able to access.

Libraries serve everyone regardless of income, education, physical ability or background. They provide resources for students, job-seekers, families and lifelong learners. The Lebanon Community Library is an invaluable resource for children and adults. In 2019, residents of Lebanon:

- Made 195,000 visits to the library

- Took advantage of 93,000 free computer and WiFi sessions
