This book explores how the ever-growing #MeToo Movement has already made an impact on our society. 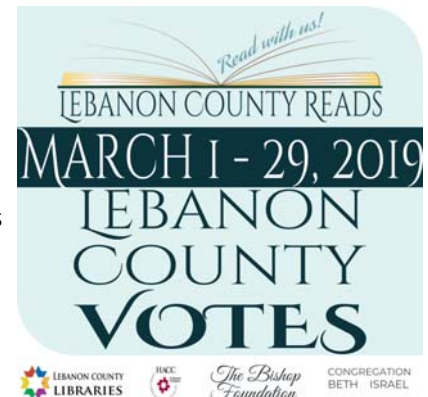
