
North Cornwall Township RECYCLING NEWS

GRASS-GYCLING

(GRASS RECYCLING)

Don't bag it, just mulch it! Mulching your lawn is the best remedy for a healthier yard. Whatever you do, <u>DO NOT</u> throw your grass clippings in with your regular trash. This takes up much needed space in our landfill for materials that are not reusable.

So how do you "grass-cycle?" Just mow often and cut less than 1/3 of the growth when mowing. Don't let large clumps of grass accumulate on your lawn. Allow your clippings to stay on the lawn. They will break down within 7 to 14 days. The nutrients from the decomposing grass will make your lawn greener & healthier!
