Lebanon County Recycling Programs Compliments of the Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority



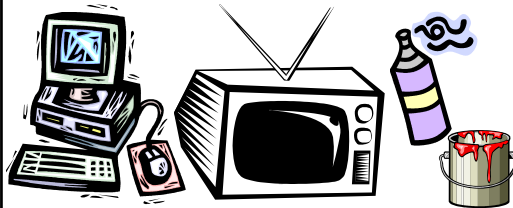
FREE* disposal for any Lebanon County residence and/or business.
