**Intersection Improvement Project
SR 2001 Section 013 Lebanon County
North Cornwall Township and City of Lebanon, Lebanon County**

As shown on the color plans displayed at North Cornwall Township, City of Lebanon, County Planning, and Lebanon School District Building and Grounds offices, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is proposing improvements to S.R. 2001 (Cornwall Road) with realignment of a portion of Township Road T-774 (Wilhelm Avenue) to make a 4-way intersection at the existing York Street intersection. Thank you for reviewing the preliminary construction plans for the project known as S.R. 2001 Section 013 Lebanon County (MPMS No. 99081).

The proposed project will include a new traffic signal at the intersection with pedestrian accommodations for crossing the roadway. During construction the project will maintain traffic in staged construction and may include minimal duration detours for roadway tie-in work. The project will also include utility relocations and right of way acquisitions. A portion of the Lebanon School District sports complex walking trail will be required to be relocated as part of this project. In accordance with Section 2002 of "PA Act 120" and PennDOT transportation project environmental clearance procedures, this recreational facility will have a *de minimus* impact to the property as a Section 4(f) resource.
