

**GLONINGER WOODS PARK PARTNERS PROGRAM****PARK PARTNERS - ADOPT-A-MILE MARKER POST**

The Adopt-A-Mile Marker Post Program is for someone who wishes to adopt a Park Trail Mile Marker Post in memory or honor of a loved one, to celebrate a special event, or for personal recognition. An adopted Park Trail Mile Marker Post is a tribute and a lifetime memorial gift in their honor. An adopted Park Trail Mile Marker Post can acknowledge a celebratory event such as a birthday, anniversary, or any special occasion.

A Memory or Celebration Park Trail Mile Marker Post can be adopted with a tax-deductible contribution. In recognition of the Donor's donation, North Cornwall Township will install a personalized plaque on one of the mile markers post, along the walking path in the Gloninger Woods Park, located at 22nd and Chestnut Streets in North Cornwall Township. The location choice of a Park Trail Mile Marker Post will be on a first-come reserved basis.

A Park Trail Mile Marker may be endowed permanently for the tax-deductible amount of \$300. Donor contributions will help fund the costs of the installation of the Park Trail Mile Marker Posts, as well as the perpetual maintenance of their Mile Marker Post.

North Cornwall Township offers contribution installment options. The tax-deductible donation of \$300.00 for the Adopt-A- Mile Marker Post Program can be made in full, or as a three-year installment payment plan. A three-year installment plan would require an initial \$100.00 payment and two remaining \$100.00 payments by June 30th of each year.

The Park Trail Mile Marker Post plaque will approximately be 3" by 5" long, dark green with white lettering, and will be permanently mounted on top of the Mile Marker Post. After the application is completed and submitted with payment, it will take approximately four weeks until the plaque is delivered and mounted. North Cornwall Township will maintain the Park Trail Mile Marker Post and mounted plaque to ensure it remains in good condition.
