

**GLONINGER WOODS PARK PARTNERS PROGRAM****PARK PARTNERS - ADOPT-A-BASEBALL PLAYER BENCH**

The Adopt-A-Baseball Player Bench Program is for individual, business or group who wishes to adopt a Baseball Player's Bench in memory or honor of a loved one, advertise, or to celebrate a special event or achievement. An adopted Baseball Player Bench is a tribute and a lifetime memorial gift in their honor. An adopted Baseball Player Bench can acknowledge the support of youth baseball, or a celebratory event or advertise a business. The benches are located within the dugout area of the little league baseball fields.

A Baseball Player Bench can be adopted with a tax-deductible contribution, and chosen from one of the eight benches within the Gloninger Woods Park, located at 22nd and Chestnut Streets in North Cornwall Township. A choice from one of the Baseball Player benches will be on a first-come reserved basis.

In recognition of the Donor's tax-deductible donation, North Cornwall Township will install a personalized, engraved permanent plaque on the Baseball Player Bench

A Baseball Player Bench may be endowed for the tax-deductible amount of \$500 and will reserve the Donor's choice of a dugout bench. Donor contributions will help fund the costs of the installation of the Baseball Player Bench, as well as the continued maintenance of their adopted player bench.

North Cornwall Township offers contribution installment options. The tax-deductible donation of \$500.00 for the Adopt-A-Baseball Player Bench Program can be made in full, or as a three-year installment payment plan. A three-year installment plan would require an initial \$200.00 payment and two remaining \$150.00 payments by June 30th of each year.

The Baseball Player Bench plaque will be 3" by 8" long, your choice of background color with lettering, and will be permanently mounted on the top bench board. After the application is completed and submitted with payment, it will take approximately four weeks until the plaque is delivered and mounted. North Cornwall Township will perpetually maintain the bench and mounted plaque, to ensure it's in good condition.
