

**GLONINGER WOODS PARK PARTNERS PROGRAM****PARK PARTNERS - ADOPT-A-BATTING CAGE**

The Adopt-A-Batting Cage is for a business, individual or group who wish to sponsor and have the naming rights for the Park's Baseball Batting Cage located near the two little league baseball fields. The financial sponsorship of a baseball batting cage demonstrates your support of the Park, and the Community's little league youth baseball programs.

An adopted Baseball Batting Cage advertisement can promote a business, the support of youth sports, or a celebratory event such as a birthday, anniversary, or any special occasion.

The adopted Baseball Batting Cage will be located next to the lower little league baseball field, east of the walking path, in the Gloninger Woods Park, at 22<sup>nd</sup> and Chestnut Streets in North Cornwall Township.

A Baseball Batting Cage may be endowed for the tax-deductible amount of \$1000.00. The Donor's contributions will help fund the batting cage's installation and maintenance costs. In recognition of the Donor's tax-deductible donation, North Cornwall Township will install two (2) personalized signs on the Batting Cage Posts.

North Cornwall Township offers contribution installment options. The tax-deductible donation of \$1000.00 for the Adopt-A-Batting Cage Program can be made in full, or as a three-year installment payment plan. A three-year installment plan would require an initial \$500.00 payment and two remaining \$250.00 payments by June 30<sup>th</sup> of each year.

The Baseball Batting Cage signs will be 18" by 24" long, and will be permanently mounted on the batting cage frame, and will remain displayed mounted year-round, for park visitors to view. After the application is completed and submitted with payment, it will take approximately four weeks until the sign is delivered and mounted. North Cornwall Township will permanently maintain the cage and mounted signs to ensure signs remain in good view and condition.
