PARK PARTNERS - ADOPT-A-TREE PROGRAM

The Adopt-A-Tree Program is for someone who wishes to adopt a Park tree in memory or honor of a loved one, or to celebrate a special event or achievement. An adopted Park tree in someone's name is a tribute and a lifetime memorial in their honor. An adopted Park tree can acknowledge a celebratory event such as a birthday, anniversary, or any special occasion.

A commemorative Park Tree which will be a perpetual memorialization, can be adopted with a tax-deductible contribution and chosen from any trees located along the park trails, within the Gloninger Woods Park, located at 22nd and Chestnut Streets in North Cornwall Township. Adopt-A-Tree selections will be on a first-come reserved basis. During the next few years, additional park trees will be planted in the Gloninger Woods Park.

In recognition of the Donor's tax-deductible donation, North Cornwall Township will install a personalized, engraved permanent sign mounted at the base of the tree.

A Park Tree may be endowed for the tax-deductible amount of \$400 and will reserve the Donor's choice of a Park Tree. Donor contributions will help fund the costs of the planting and lifetime maintenance of their adopted Park tree.

North Cornwall Township offers contribution installment options. The tax-deductible donation of \$400.00 for the Adopt-A-Tree Program can be made in full, or as a three-year installment payment plan. A three-year installment plan would require an initial \$200.00 payment and two remaining \$100 payments by June 30th of each year.

The sign will be approximately 4" by 6" long, dark green with white lettering, and will be permanently mounted on a post, in front of the tree. After the attached application is completed and submitted with payment, it will take approximately four weeks until the plague is delivered and mounted. North Cornwall Township will maintain the park tree and mounted plaque, to ensure it's in good condition.
